

# SECURLY Parent Portal for DCA

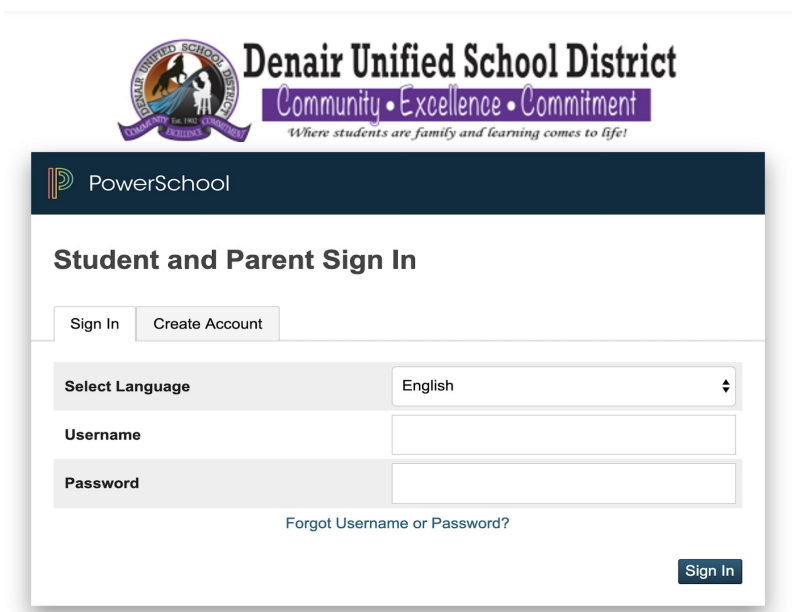
Denair Charter Academy uses your Powerschool Parent Portal email address to start your SECURLY account.

PowerSchool Parent Portal email addresses are uploaded to SECURLY every Friday. SECURLY then sends an email invitation to you to log into SECURLY by the following Wednesday.

To start you will need a Power School Parent Portal account.

1. To create your Powerschool Parent Portal account, you will need to use the Denair USD passcode **TWXQ** and also have your student's Access ID number and phone number of record
2. Go <https://powerschool.dusd.k12.ca.us/public/> and click Create New Account.

1. You will then begin getting weekly emails from SECURLY on your student's web activity. You can log into SECURLY by clicking on the link in your weekly email or by going directly to SECURLY's Parent Portal - <https://www.securly.com/parent-login>
2. What can you do in SECURLY parent portal:
  - a. **Activity:** View and search your student's web activity and/or download the report
  - b. **Flagged:** View Flagged sites and keywords that have been searched
  - c. **Settings:** Block or allow sites for your student when they are NOT at school
    - i. Parents control off campus access and DCA controls on campus access
